Community Connections challenges social isolation and supports adults experiencing low mood, isolation or who would like to be more connected to their local community. They take a person- centred approach and will meet with you to talk about your interests and wellbeing. They can help you plan how you can achieve your goals, learn new skills, find volunteering opportunities or link you to local clubs or groups. Community Connections works with dozens of community groups who can offer activities such as Art, crafting, gardening, walking groups, mental health support, carer's group and LGBTQI+ groups. Community Connections can also link you to practical support such as transport schemes, gardening, and odd jobs. Toenail and fingernail cutting. Home adaptations, money management, debt advice, domestic violence support and culturally specific

support.

Rent Rise for Brockley owned Properties 2024.

This year's rent rise for Brockley owned properties was discussed at the Management Committee Meeting on 27th February 2024. Members voted unanimously not to impose the 7.7% rise that is the maximum any social landlords can charge using the rent setting formula (September CPI plus 1%). Members voted for a 4% increase; this will be applied from July. Hexagon have confirmed their rent increase they will impose 7.7% from July. If you are worried about money let us know. Rent Arrears Matter

In April 2022 rent owed to the Coop was over £70,000. In April 2024 we are pleased to report that rent arrears are now £58,000. As rent is our only income, we are dependent on members paying so that we can carry out repairs, improvements and have staff you can talk to if you need help. Please continue to ensure that rent remains a priority bill for you to pay and help us to reduce this amount even further. We could carry out a lot of works with the £58,000 we are currently owed and with Coop rents being the most affordable within the social housing sector it is hard to justify this level of arrears. We will be targeting those who do not pay consistently or will not make agreements to clear their debts don't let that be you - court costs can add an additional £391 to your debts.
